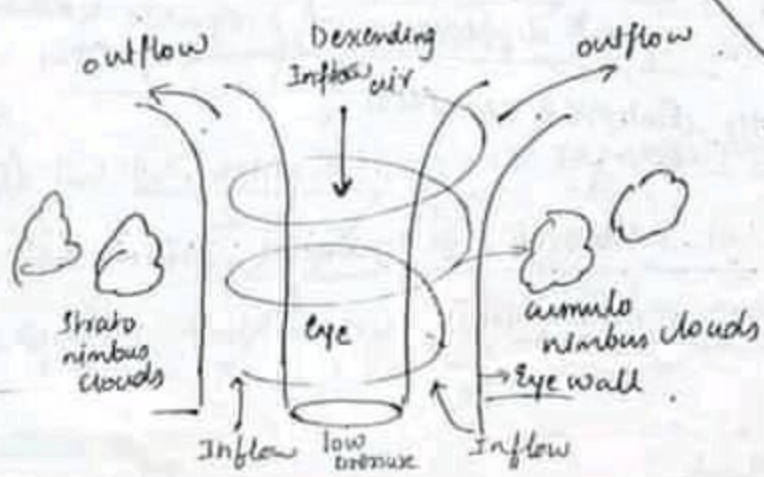

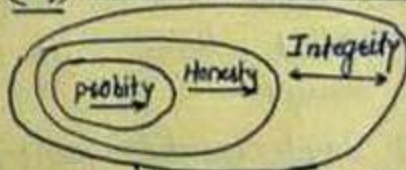

During Cop21 in 2015, it was agreed by the countries to limit global temperature rise below 1.5°C but according to recent report by IPCC, with the ongoing trend of emission, limiting global warming seems a far-fetched dream.

Concern of Climate Change -

- According to 1.5 IPCC Report, if more efforts are not put by the countries to limit GHG emissions, the global temperature may rise above 1.5°C.

It also highlighted that with more focused efforts, temperature rise can be limited. For that, countries need to cut their emissions by 50% by 2030 and become carbon neutral (Carbon source = carbon sink) by 2050.

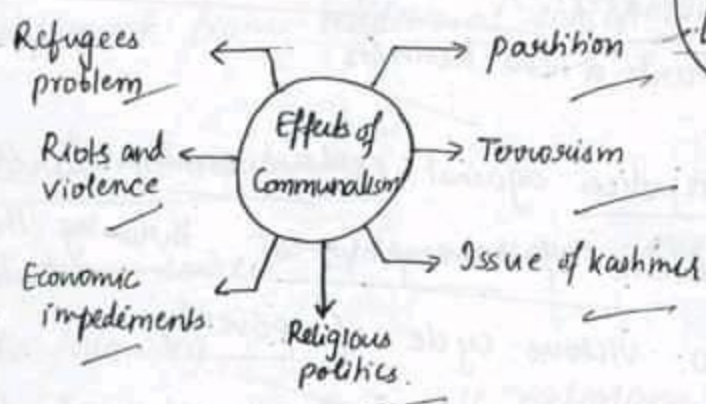
- It also highlighted that CO₂ level in atmosphere have reached unprecedented levels of 410ppm which clearly indicates that global warming and climate change are real and are caused by anthropogenic activities. These activities have minimised ecosystem resilience and are caused by anthropogenic activities. ex: Conspicuous oceanic acidification microorganisms

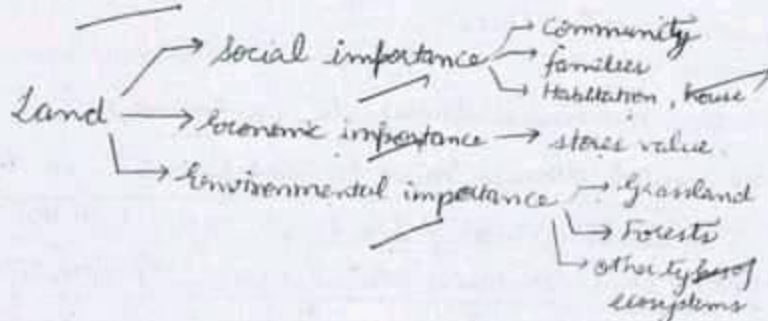

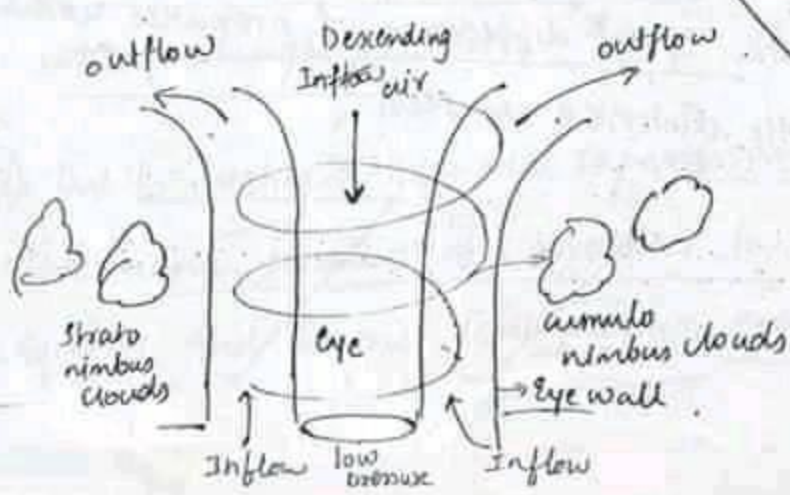
